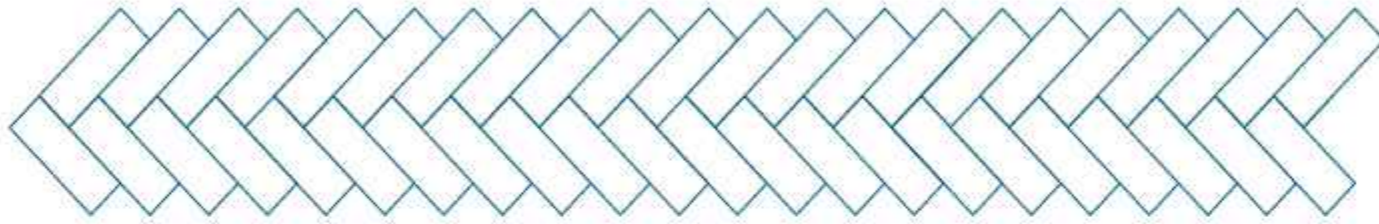

This specialised process of handcrafting results in an original brushed board that is unique in color and texture. The beauty of real engineered European Oak is in the natural variations of color and grain in addition to knots through your Castel Nuovo flooring. By highlighting the unique characteristics of European Oak through the finishing process, this board opens a world of options for color palettes and paints in your décor and styling, which is ideal for not only foyers and hallways, but open spaces throughout the home.

The prefinished 600mm x 120mm x 14mm T & G board comes with a left and right tongue and is finished with a UV lacquer ultra matt finish. The cross-layer construction of the multi-ply core allows the boards to maintain stability even over radiant heated subfloor systems. The pre-finished engineered European Oak board requires less time and mess with installation than traditional raw parquet floors. Installation by full trowel is required. MULTI-PLY CORE STRUCTURE



The manufacturing of Engineered flooring is typically more resource efficient and cost effective when compared to solid timbers.

The stability of the Multi-ply Core structure Engineered Flooring is much better because its arrangement is criss-crossed, the layers run perpendicular to each other. This not only offsets the internal stress of the wood, but also changes the unidirectional homogeneity of the wood, making the floor become isotropic and very stable. Expansion and contraction are usually less of a problem. This increased stability also gives you the option to go with wide planks while still being cost effective.
